

13 <sup>a</sup>They <sup>l</sup>gaped upon me *with* their mouths, *as* a <sup>2</sup>ravening and a roaring lion.

14 I am poured out like water, <sup>a</sup>and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted <sup>l</sup>in the midst of my bowels.

15 <sup>a</sup>My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and <sup>b</sup>my tongue <sup>l</sup>cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death.

16 For dogs have <sup>l</sup>compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: <sup>a</sup>they pierced my hands and my feet.

17 I <sup>l</sup>may tell all my bones: <sup>a</sup>they look *and* stare upon me.

18 <sup>a</sup>They <sup>l</sup>part my garments among them, and cast lots <sup>2</sup>upon my vesture.

19 But be not thou far from me, O LORD: O my strength, haste thee to help me.

20 Deliver my soul from the sword; <sup>a</sup>my <sup>l</sup>darling from the power of the dog.

21 <sup>a</sup>Save me from the lion's mouth: <sup>b</sup>for<sup>l</sup> thou hast heard me from the horns of the unicorns.

22 <sup>a</sup>I will declare thy name unto <sup>b</sup>my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.

23 <sup>a</sup>Ye that fear the LORD, praise him; all ye the <sup>l</sup>seed of Jacob, glorify him; and <sup>2</sup>fear him, all ye the seed of Israel.

24 For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but <sup>a</sup>when he cried unto him, he heard.

25 <sup>a</sup>My praise *shall be* of thee in the great congregation: <sup>b</sup>I will pay my vows before them that fear him.

26 The meek shall eat and be

satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek him: your heart shall live for ever.

27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before thee.

28 <sup>a</sup>For the kingdom *is* the LORD's: and he *is* the governor among the nations.

29 <sup>a</sup>All *they that* <sup>l</sup>be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: <sup>b</sup>all they that go down to <sup>2</sup>the dust shall bow before him: and none can <sup>3</sup>keep alive his own soul.

30 A <sup>l</sup>seed shall serve him; it shall be <sup>2</sup>accounted to the Lord for a generation.

31 They shall come, and shall declare his righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that he hath done *this*.

**T**HE LORD *is* <sup>a</sup>my shepherd; <sup>b</sup>I shall not <sup>l</sup>want.

2 <sup>a</sup>He maketh me to lie down in <sup>l</sup>green pastures: <sup>b</sup>he leadeth me beside the <sup>2</sup>still waters.

5 Thou <sup>a</sup>preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou <sup>b</sup>anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

6 Surely goodness and <sup>l</sup>mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

PSALM 24

A Psalm of David.

**T**HE <sup>a</sup>earth *is* the LORD's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

2 For he hath <sup>a</sup>founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the <sup>l</sup>floods.

3 <sup>a</sup>Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place?

4 He that hath <sup>a</sup>clean hands, and <sup>b</sup>a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul <sup>l</sup>unto vanity, nor <sup>c</sup>sworn deceitfully.

5 He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.

6 This *is* the generation of them that <sup>a</sup>seek him, that seek thy face, O Jacob. *Selah.*

7 <sup>a</sup>Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; <sup>b</sup>and the King of glory shall come in.

8 Who *is* this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in <sup>a</sup>battle.

9 Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift *them* up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

10 Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he *is* the King of glory. *Selah.*

PSALM 25

A Psalm of David.

**U**NTO <sup>a</sup>thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.

2 O my God, I <sup>a</sup>trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, <sup>b</sup>let not mine enemies triumph over me.

3 Yea, let none that <sup>l</sup>wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which <sup>2</sup>transgress without cause.

4 <sup>a</sup>Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.

5 Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou *art* the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.

6 Remember, O LORD, <sup>a</sup>thy tender mercies and thy lovingkindnesses; for they *have been* ever of old.

7 Remember not <sup>a</sup>the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: <sup>b</sup>according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD.

8 Good and upright *is* the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.
